Info Sheet Pete Seeger Biographical Sketch

Pete Seeger was born in New York on May 3, 1919. He is a singer and a songwriter. In 1940 Seeger formed the Almanac Singers, and their repertoire of radical songs marked the start of the protest movement. They performed mainly at union rallies, strikes, and protests. The group disbanded during World War II when Seeger was drafted.
